

CAMBRIDGE HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM GUIDELINES

Cambridge High School students are required to wear their uniform neatly and completely.

We aim to develop self-responsibility in our students for wearing the uniform correctly at all times. Occasionally there is a justified reason for incorrect uniform items. In this case, the student needs to get a uniform pass from the House Deans to excuse the item(s). Repeated instances of wearing school uniform incorrectly and without a uniform pass, will be treated as defiant behaviour and whaanau will be involved in resolving the concern.

All uniform items are to be as sold by the Uniform Shoppe - theuniformshoppe.co.nz

ALL STUDENTS

- **SHOES** <u>Plain black lace-up shoes, preferably leather or leather look</u> (not boots).
- SOCKS
 <u>Style A</u> white or black ankle socks, or navy or black pantyhouse (colder months).
 <u>Style B</u> CHS school socks with blue and white band ONLY.
- **SANDALS** <u>Summer only (Term 1 and 4)</u> Plain black or brown (tidy) Roman style sandals. Sandals must have a strap over the front of the foot, a back strap, be flat soled, and have black or silver buckles only. No slip ons and no socks with sandals.
- **OPTIONAL**: CHS jacket with school crest.
 - Plain navy blue, black or white scarf.
 - Regulation school cap.
 - Navy blue or black raincoat, worn to and from school only, not in classes. No puffer jackets permitted.

APPEARANCE

- Hair is to be kept clean and tidy. Natural coloured dyed hair is acceptable. However, extreme hairstyles/colours are not permitted at school.
 - Only permitted jewellery items. This includes:
 - Sleepers or plain stud earrings (up to three per ear).
 - One small discreet ring.
 - One bracelet.
 - One culturally significant item, such as a taonga, worn around the neck.
 - One small discreet stud nose piercing. Rings are not permitted.
 - Other body piercings are not permitted (i.e. eyebrow, lip, septum).
- Neutral make-up and neutral nail polish only (i.e. light pink, peach, tan). Acrylic and gel nails are not permitted.
- No facial hair. Where exceptions have been made (with SLT) for cultural reasons, this must be kept clean and tidy.
- No visible tattoos.



UNIFORM STYLE A

YEAR 9 TO 12 - UNIFORM ITEMS

- CHS Navy blue shorts or tartan skirt.
- White short sleeved blouse with crest.
- Navy jersey with school crest.
- Any headbands must be white, black or navy blue.

YEAR 13 – UNIFORM ITEMS

Winter & Formal Uniform

(The formal uniform will be worn on assembly days, other occasions and days designated by the Principal. It will be worn without the tie as the standard winter uniform).

- Long navy skirt.
- White blouse, short sleeved (N.B. blouse is designed to be worn out, not tucked in)
- Grey jersey with school crest.
- CHS school tie (either blue, white and navy striped tie, academic tie, or sports tie)

Summer (Non-Formal)

- White short sleeved blouse with crest
- CHS navy blue shorts or navy skirt

UNIFORM STYLE B

YEAR 9 TO 12 - UNIFORM ITEMS

- School navy shorts OR school navy trousers.
- Navy polo shirt with crest.
- Navy jersey with school crest.
- Belt must be plain black only.

YEAR 13 – UNIFORM ITEMS

Winter & Formal Uniform

(The formal uniform will be worn on assembly days, other occasions and days designated by the Principal. It will be worn without the tie as the standard winter uniform).

- Navy school trousers.
- Short sleeved chambray shirt with crest (designed to be worn out).
- Grey jersey with school crest.
- CHS school tie (either blue, white and navy striped tie, academic tie, or sports tie).

Year 13 Non-Formal Uniform

- School navy shorts OR school navy trousers.
- Short sleeved chambray shirt with crest (polo shirts are not acceptable)



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Please note the following FAQ for uniform items:

- All students may choose from Uniform Style A OR Uniform Style B. However, the complete uniform must be worn from each style, not crossing over the two styles i.e. the tartan skirt cannot be worn with the blue polo.
- All shirts and blouses are designed to be worn out, not tucked in.
- The winter uniform is also the formal uniform, to be worn as required when representing the school and for formal school attire
- The winter uniform may be supported by a thermal layer. This layer must be discrete, worn beneath the shirt and as close as possible to the same colour as the shirt, plain and with no branding on the sleeves.
- Those in Uniform Style A may wear plain white or black ankle socks only. They must be visible socks, not low-cut anklets or crew socks. Those in Uniform Style B must wear school uniform socks only.
- No CHS Sports uniform items to be worn during the school day. These are reserved for trainings, sports games and events only.
- School uniform jackets are available for purchase. On days where the rain is heavy, dark blue or black non-uniform rain jackets may be worn (over a complete school uniform) to and from school and in between classes. Students are not to wear puffer jackets.
- Only approved CHS branded hats may be worn. Caps and beanies are available from The Uniform Shoppe. Bucket hats are available for purchase at our school office.
