

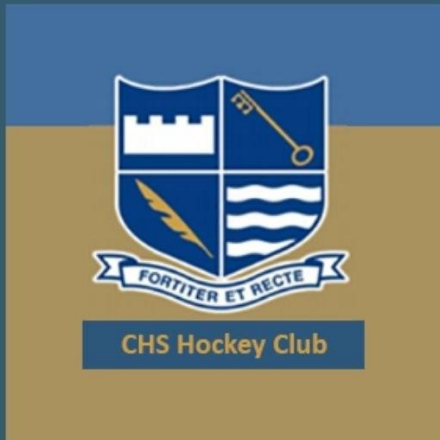
LEAVING SCHOOL EARLY

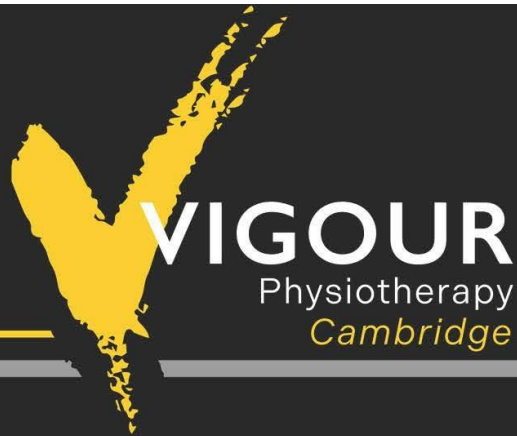
