



Badge and Tie Criteria

All recipients must be good ambassadors for CHS and always follow the schools REACH Values.

This means, as well as attaining the performance/achievement levels below in their sport, the following areas are all taken into consideration by the individual code: School attendance, school behaviour, academic work, sportsmanship and fair play, commitment to the team, coach, and training etc.

Silver Badge

- Placed in the top 3 at a WSS or NISS Champs or played in their codes Senior WSS Div 1 final. There must have been 8 or more individual/teams competing or be it at the discretion of the Team Leader – Sport and Arts.
- Selected and competed for a regional age group 'A' representative team; (i.e. Waikato, ND or equivalent in your code).

Gold Badge

- Placed in the top 3 at a NZ Secondary Schools Champs or higher or holds an NZ title/ranking at any age group.
- Selected and competed for any NZ team or event in any age group (includes non-school sports).
- There must have been 8 or more individual/teams competing or be it at the discretion of the Team Leader – Sport and Arts.

Tie

- Placed 1st at NZ Secondary School Champs or holds a NZ title at any age group (excluding novice events)
 - Selected and competed for a national team or event at any age group (includes non-school sports).
 - Only one sports tie can be awarded to a student during their time at Cambridge High School.
 - There must have been 8 or more individual/teams competing or be it at the discretion of the Team Leader – Sport and Arts.
